







Example of China compliant product label (applied during production)


NSW Emerging Export

Example of China compliant overlay label (applied after production & prior to import clearance)





PGS Enforcement of food import non compliance is covered...












FIGURE 8 – Examples of product claims that would require validation



- 1. Difficult to quantify
- Proof of certification required
- Enterprise must have China-approved organic certification
- Health claims are not allowed unless approved for import as a health product
